Police, crime prevention organisations, neighbourhood watch and insurance companies recognise window etching as one of the most powerful theft deterrents available to today’s consumer. Reasons to have your windows etched Over half a million cars are stolen every year in the UK, which works out at about one every 55 seconds! In a couple of hours your car could be in another town 100 miles away being sold on a forged logbook with false plates. Or it could be in a container headed abroad stolen to order like many thousands of others. Whilst there are still cars without their windows etched why would a thief chose one that has been marked and means so much more trouble. 1. He has to order, fit and pay for a full set of windows; there are no set of normal circumstances where you need a full set of windows and ordering them would immediately arouse suspicion. 2. The cost would be substantial and on some vehicles it would cost thousands. 3. A thief knows that fitting a full set of windows is a big job even on a small car. 4. He has to hide the car whilst changing the windows and has to destroy or dispose of the glass he takes out. An Unmarked car says that the owner is security conscious, conversely a marked car says the owner is security aware and that there may be more devices inside such as immobilisers. Security is not about making your car impregnable but simply taking it off the top of the thieves’ list. Police all over the world advise that alarms and etching go together. One of the things that’s so nice about etching is that there is nothing to go wrong with it, once it’s on, it is there forever! Police can access Police National Computer immediately from anywhere and check the above numbers almost instantly. Leaflets issued by the police always recommend car window etching. You can get some from your local crime prevention officer. One report showed that here in the United Kingdom the theft rate in window etched cars is about one in 2500, compared with the national average of one in 45. That’s 60 times less likely!
